#### ORDINANCE NO. 173-1994

AMENDING ORDINANCE 238-1984 ENTITLED "ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE USE OF CERTAIN COUNTY OWNED AND/OR OPERATED FACILITIES."

(Passed by Board of Supervisors on April 25, 1994. Votes for 108; votes against, none. Became an ordinance on April 25, 1994 with the approval of the Deputy County Executive Acting for the County Executive.)

WHEREAS, to promote and protect the public health, welfare and safety of the community by regulating advertisements on the public

roadways. It is intended to create a more attractive economic and business climate, enhance and protect the physical appearance of the community, preserve the scenic and natural beauty and provide a more enjoyable and pleasing community. It is further intended to reduce sign clutter or advertising distractions and obstructions that may contribute to traffic accidents, reduce hazards that may be caused by signs overhanging or projecting over public roadways.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NASSAU, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 238-1984 as amended by Ordinance No. 152-1993 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 1. There are hereby established rules and regulations relating to the use of all County owned and/or operated facilities including Nassau Community College but specifically excluding the Nassau Veterans Memorial Coliseum and all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Nassau County Department of Recreation and Parks; and all trees, pumps, hydrants, sign posts, telegraph, telephone or electric poles, telephone booths, sign posts, traffic light poles, and street lamps within the County of Nassau.

Section 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 238-1984 as amended by Ordinance No. 152-1993 is hereby further amended to add a new subparagraph "m" as follows:

m. Prohibition of Posting Bills.

No person or persons shall placard, post or display with show bills, hand bills, posters, banners, or any printed or written notice or notices or advertisement of any kind whatsoever, or attach anything whatsoever of such character to any tree, pump, hydrant, telegraph, telephone or electric poles, telephone booths, sign posts, traffic light poles and street lamps within the County of Nassau.

Any person including private citizens may remove and cart away any show bills, hand bills, banners, posters or any printed or written notices or advertisements that have been placard posted and/or displayed in violation of this ordinance.

§3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
